TRADE SUMMARY July-September, 2021

EXPORTS

The total exports of Pakistan during Jul-Sep, 2021 amounted to Rs. 1,147,072.93 million showing an increase of 12.27% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and 25.74% over Jul-Sep, 2020.

In terms of US dollar, the export during Jul-Sep, 2021 amounted to \$6,996.14 million showing an increase of 5.73% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 27.86% over Jul-Sep, 2020.

IMPORTS

The total imports of Pakistan during Jul-Sep, 2021 amounted to Rs. 3,072,047.84 million showing an increase of 17.87% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 63.29% over Jul-Sep, 2020.

In terms of US dollar, the imports during Jul-Sep, 2021 amounted to \$ 18,715.17 million showing an increase of 10.80% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 65.82% over Jul-Sep, 2020.

TOTAL TRADE

The total trade of Pakistan during Jul-Sep, 2021 amounted to Rs. 4,219,120.77 million showing an increase of 16.29% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 51.03% over Jul-Sep, 2020.

In terms of US dollar, the total trade during Jul-Sep, 2021 amounted to \$ 16,757.92 million showing an increase of 9.38% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 53.43% over Jul-Sep, 2020.


BALANCE OF TRADE







I – EXPORT BY GROUP/COMMODITIES

Food Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 export of goods belonging to Food Group decreased by 10.84% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and increased by 10.41% over Jul-Sep, 2020. Food Group contributed 9.33% of total exports.

Textile Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 export of Textile goods increased by 15.71% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 24.96% over Jul-Sep, 2020. Textile Group contributed 60.35% of total exports.

Manufactures Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 export of manufactured goods increased by 3.45% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 0.42% over Jul-Sep, 2020. Manufactures Group contributed 6.24% of total exports.

II – DIRECTION OF EXPORTS

During the quarter Jul-Sep, 2021, the share of European Union in total exports was 35.53% as against 37.78% in Jul-Sep, 2020. The share of North America in total exports was 22.41% as against 22.09% in Jul-Sep, 2020. The share of Other Asia during Jul-Sep, 2021 was 23.49% as against 20.68% in Jul-Sep, 2020. The share of Middle East during Jul-Sep, 2021 was 9.61% as against 10.70% in Jul-Sep, 2020. The share of Other Africa during Jul-Sep, 2021 was 4.46% as against 4.73% in Jul-Sep, 2020. Country-wise U. S. A. was at the top of the export list for Jul-Sep, 2021 followed by China, United Kingdom, Germany, Netherlands and Spain. The share of these six countries in total exports for Jul-Sep, 2021 was 53.73% as against 51.62% in Jul-Sep, 2020.

III – EXPORT BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

Export of Primary Commodities during Jul-Sep, 2021 increased by 37.43%, Semi-Manufactures by 43.46% but Manufactured Goods decreased by 22.62% over Jul-Sep, 2020. Whereas, their share in total export stands at 13.65%, 6.96 and 79.39% respectively for Jul-Sep, 2021.

I – IMPORTS BY GROUPS/COMMODITIES

Food Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 import of goods belonging to Food Group increased by 8.74% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 37.67% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 7.02% of total imports.

Machinery & Transport Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 import of goods belonging to Machinery & Transport group increased by 5.26% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 54.47% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 21.00% of total imports.

Petroleum Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 import of goods belonging to Petroleum group increased by 30.32% over Apr-Jun, 2021 & by 85.49% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 18.31% of total imports.

Textile Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 import of goods belonging to textile group increased by 45.50% over Apr-Jun 2021 and by 63.55% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 2.51% of total imports.

Chemical Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 import of goods belonging to Chemical group increased by 22.81% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 74.49% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 18.29% of total imports.

Metal Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 export of Metal products increased by 32.80% over Apr-Jun, 2021 and by 38.63% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 6.47% of total imports.

Miscellaneous Group

During Jul-Sep, 2021 exports of miscellaneous commodities slightly increased by 1.86% over Apr- Jun, 2021 and by 2.62% over Jul-Sep, 2020. This group contributed 1.03% of total imports.

II – DIRECTION OF IMPORTS

During the month of Jul-Sep, 2021, the share of Other Asia in total imports was 46.99% as against 47.17% in Jul-Sep, 2020. The share of Middle East during Jul-Sep, 2021 was 28.34% as against 25.11% in Jul-Sep, 2020. The share of European Union during Jul-Sep, 2021 was 7.55% as against 10.64% in Jul-Sep, 2020. Country-wise China was at the top of the import list for Jul-Sep, 2021 followed by United Arab Emirates, Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, U. S. A. and Qatar. The share of these six countries in total exports for Jul-Sep, 2021 was 59.36% as against 56.34 in Jul-Sep, 2020.

III – IMPORTS BY ECONOMIC CATEGORIES

Imports of Consumer Goods during Jul-Sep, 2021 increased by 82.62%, Raw Material for Consumer Goods by 67.73%, Capital Goods by 53.21% and Raw Material for Capital Goods by 39.71% over Jul-Sep, 2020. Their respective share in total imports were 20.30%, 44.44%, 25.50% and 9.76% respectively for Jul-Sep, 2021.
