

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Sex Ratio

The Sex Ratio was 106 in the year 2005, whereas it was 108 according to 1998 Population Census.

Crude Birth Rate (CBR)

The Crude Birth Rate calculated for the year 2005 was 26.1 per thousand population, which showed a decline of 2 percent as compared to 26.5 in 2003

General Fertility Rate (GFR)

The General Fertility Rate derived for the year 2005 was 110.6 per thousand women, which is 3.9 percent point lower as compared to 114.5 in 2003.

Total Fertility Rate (TFR)

The Total Fertility Rate was 3.8 children per woman of reproductive age (15-49 years) in 2005, whereas, it was 3.9 in 2003.

Crude Death Rate (CDR)

The Crude Death Rate was 7.1 per thousand populations for the year 2005. As compared to 7.0 in 2003. The crude death rate in rural areas was higher as compared to urban areas. The crude death rate has declined about 19 percent during last 10 years.

Infant Mortality Rate (IMR)

About 76.7 infant deaths per thousand live births were recorded in the year 2005, whereas, it was 76.2 in 2003.

Natural Growth Rate

The Natural Growth Rate of population for the year 2005 was 1.90 percent per annum as compared to 1.95 in the year 2003.

Life Expectancy at Birth

The Life Expectancy at birth was 64 years for males and 66 years for females in 2005.
